



2026 AUTOCROSS LEAGUE RULES

1. Overview

The **CMF 2026 Autocross League** will be Cayman's first structured national autocross championship—designed to promote driver skill, safety, and community participation through six (6) competitive events held **from January to December 2026**.

Each event will feature a timed slalom-style course focusing on precision and control, with points contributing toward an overall **National Autocross Champion** title.

League participation will be open to all licensed CMF National Autocross Drivers.

2. League Objectives

- Establish a sustainable, FIA-aligned grassroots motorsport league in the Cayman Islands.
- Develop local driver talent in a safe, controlled environment.
- Build public awareness of CMF programs (Autocross, FIA Smart Driving Challenge, STEM Racing, Esports).
- Strengthen sponsor partnerships and create commercial value for local brands.
- Collect environmental and safety data to support CMF's FIA Environmental Accreditation.

3. Licensing & Safety Framework

- All **League** drivers must hold a **CMF National C Autocross Licence** (valid Jan–Dec 2026). Valid for Autocross, Navigational Rally, Dexterity, Drift (\$25)
 - Licence fee: **CI\$25/year** (includes registration in CMF National Driver Database).
- Safety gear mandatory: helmet, seatbelt/harness, long pants, T-Shirt, no open-toed shoes.
- Event run under **FIA's National Sporting Code (NSC)** and **FIA Appendix H** safety standards.

4. League Structure

Venue	Foster's Airport Lot or alternate approved venue
Participants	15–30 drivers per event Street Street Modified High Performance/Race TBD by CMF officials, do we announce categories at the start of events or determine at the end.
Licensing	Valid Cayman Island DL required for all drivers. CMF C Licence (Autocross) to participate for League. Request link to complete registration – info@caymanmotoringfederation.org
Scoring System	Points per event (25-18-15-12-10 top 5 positions) per category. Best 4 of 6 rounds count toward Championship.
Awards	1st–3rd Overall, Class Champions, Women in Motorsport Trophy, Junior Champion, Most improved overall.
Timing	Electronic timing system with printed leaderboards
Safety	Marshals trained via FIA-approved Officials Programme; first aid and fire extinguishers on site

5. Racer Rules

1. Eligibility:

- Must be a CMF Member in good standing.
- Must hold a valid Cayman Island Drivers Licence.
- Car Park event:
 - i. CMF Licenced (Autocross) Member - \$25.00
 - ii. CMF Member - \$50.00
 - iii. CMF NON-member: \$75.00
- Road Events – Possible increase in fees due to logistics (you'll be notified)

2. Vehicle Regulations:

- Street-legal cars with current registration and insurance.
Helmet (DOT/Snell approved) encouraged but not required, long pants, T-Shirt, closed toe shoes.
No loose interior items; tires and brakes in good condition.
- Must pass mandatory vehicle inspection conducted by CMF.

3. Competition Format:

- Each driver receives 2 practice (with CMF instructor) and 3-4 timed runs (depending on entries and location); Fastest 2 times counts.
- Cones = +2 seconds penalty each
- Drift/Lose control = +5 seconds penalty for car park events.
- ALL Events, Red Flag, must stop and return to start. Also considered a DNF.
- Missed gate = DNF (Did Not Finish).

4. Code of Conduct:

- Zero tolerance for reckless driving or substance/drug use.
- Respect officials, marshals, and other competitors.

Clerk of the Course	Course layout, driver briefing, and rule enforcement
Chief Marshal	Manages marshals and flagging
Chief Timekeeper	Manages timing and scoring systems
Environmental Officer	Ensures sustainability & waste-management compliance
Marketing Lead	Promotes event and manages sponsor visibility
Treasurer/Finance Lead	Collects entry fees, manages event budget
Medical & Fire Officer	On-site emergency readiness
